## Minutes

Meeting began at 4:05 pm

- 1. Introductions
  - a. LCCs Angell, Mansfield, and Ramos
  - b. Principal Jon Oates
  - c. Specialists Santa and Garcia
  - d. Group icebreaker to start the meeting
- 2. Addressed the recent events in Texas and shared community resources for dealing with crises.
- 3. LCAP
  - Discussed what LCAP is and where our school receives funding
  - b. Total projected revenue is \$39,219,738. Funding is used to address several priorities including increasing parent involvement and efforts to seek input from parents and other stakeholders.
  - c. Vista Real uses the CA Department of Education's self-reflection tools in unison with school surveys to report progress on the local performance indicator to educational partners and the public.
  - d. Based on LCAP data, we've identified three areas of improvement
    - i. Math and ELA CAASPP scores
    - ii. English Learner Reclassification
    - iii. CTE enrollment
  - e. Allowed time for stakeholders to comment and provide feedback (none given)
- 4. What is Reclassification
  - a. California state law requires all schools to administer the English language proficiency assessment for California (ELPAC) exam to all English Language Learners who have not yet reclassified.
  - b. The ELPAC is used to identify and monitor EL students' progress toward English language proficiency. EL students continue to take the Summative ELPAC

annually until they meet the reclassification criteria.

- 5. Importance of Credit Completion/HS diploma/year-round school
  - a. Vista Real is a Year Round School.
    - Summer: Students attend school and turn in credits in July August and September
    - ii. June 13-30th: No on campus appointments. But students must continue to do work to keep pace to graduate!
    - iii. Get credits to complete from your teacher before June 10th!
    - iv. Reminder for parents to sign master agreement for the upcoming school year
    - v. Graduation is on June 9th at 4:00pm at Ventura College. Last day for students to turn in credits is May 27th.

## 6. Sports and Pathway update

- a. Potential sports that will be offered: tennis, cross country, soccer, basketball, volleybal
- b. Asked stakeholders for feedback about programs they are most interested in seeing.
