3. What is LCAP
 - The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is how schools set goals for spending resources to help improve student outcomes. Schools are required to draft a three-year plan and share that plan with stakeholders (staff, parents, and students). The three-year plan is updated and approved by the school board each year.
 - The ELPAC is used to identify and monitor EL students' progress toward English language proficiency. EL students continue to take the Summative ELPAC annually until they meet the reclassification criteria.
 - Funding comes from LCFF formula, state funding, local funding, and federal funding
 - Local parent involvement is based on building relationships, partners, and seeking input for decision making.
4. Title 1 Funds:
 - Supplemental federal funds provided to schools with high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging academic standards.

As a means of measure and reporting, Vista Real will be using the LCAP in place of th SPSA. This meets the requirements of data driven analysis that is shared with educational partners.
