5. Title 1 Annual Information - Title 1 Part A

- Supplemental federal funds provided to schools with high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging academic standards.
- 62.4% of Vista Real students qualify for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program (2020/2021), as reported by the National School Lunch Form completed annually by parents & adult students.
- Although schools are eligible for Title 1 funding based on low income, the selection
 process for providing <u>Title 1 Services</u> to targeted students is based entirely on academic
 achievement.
 - o NWEA Scores in Math & Reading
 - Regular testing is critical
- Vista Real will be implementing the Targeted Assistance Program this school year. Next year, we will move to a Schoolwide Program.
- Average Vista Real NWEA Reading Lexile (1135, 9th grade equivalent)
- Average Vista Real NWEA Math Quantile (860, 6th grade equivalent)
- These scores indicate that students need additional academic interventions.
- Total funds to be received \$295,881
- Vista Real will use these funds;
 - o Intervention Staff
 - Instructional Materials
 - Administrative Costs (Professional Development and Audit Fees)

6. ELO

- ELO is a COVID relief package that the California legislature approved to support public schools
- Total funds to be received: \$ 2,380,885
- Vista Real will use these funds in the following areas:
 - 1. Increasing the number of support staff including:
 - Counseling Paraprofessionals
 - English Language Learner Paraprofessionals
 - Tutors
 - 2. Expanding instructional times by increasing access and extending instructional hours
 - 3. Laptops, hotspots, and other technology for students
 - 4. Providing access to student nutrition

7. LCAP Supplement

- New Senate and Assembly Bills amended California Ed Code to require revisions to the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)
- Section 124 of AB 130 requires the State Board of Education (SBE) to adopt a one-time supplement template
- For LEAs that receive a Concentration grant, the formula was adjusted so that eligible LEAs receive a 15% increase in Concentration funding only
- That expands the concentration funding from 50% per pupil to 65% per pupil for LEAs with a 55% or greater enrollment of unduplicated students
- The additional 15% concentration grant funds must be used to increase the number of certificated staff and/or classified staff (including custodial staff) who provide direct services to pupils on school campuses.
- Schools must consult with parents and family members of children receiving services and develop a written policy that describes how parents and families are involved.
