II. Approval of minutes of the previous meeting

III. ELAC Updates

Mr. Oates reviewed what ELAC stands for and why these meetings are held.

#### IV. Field Trips

##### a. America's Teaching Zoo

Mr. Oates discussed the details of the field trip including the date (March 28th, 2023), the location (Moorpark College/Zoo), and what the students will learn/do (Students will get a tour of the zoo and learn about the animal training and management programs at Moorpark College).

To conclude this topic, Mr. Oates lets guests know that they can simply ask their student's supervising teacher for a permission slip as well as more information about lunch and transportation details.

##### b. Coastal Conservation

Mr. Oates discussed the details of the field trip including the date (April 25th and 26th), the location (El Segundo beach and Santa Monica Aquarium), and what the students will learn/do (Partake in a local beach clean up in a last defense against marine pollution and spend time learning at the Santa Monica Aquarium)

##### c. Ventura College Events

Mr. Oates shared two upcoming Ventura College Events: VC Career Expo and VC Pirate Day

Mr. Oates shared that the VC Career Expo takes place on April 27th and its purpose is to meet employers from all around Ventura County in order to find part or full time jobs/internships. The link to sign up was shared.

#### V. Dual Enrollment
