II. Approval of minutes of the previous meeting

III. Title I Program Review

Cece Dullam presented the Title I a

- a. This is Vista Real's 3rd year of receiving Title 1 funds from the federal government. Because our students show a need to improve in English Language Arts, we continue to use the funds to support our Literacy Intervention Program. The Title 1 Program Evaluation is a review of the progress we made last year.
 - b. Our students have shown growth in 3 main areas of focus.
 - i. Last year, 219 more students tested in NWEA Reading than compared to the year before. They had an average growth of 60 points in their lexile scores. This means that they are making good progress in increasing towards grade level proficiency.
 - ii. The average in 21/22 was equivalent to an 8th grade reading level. The average in 22/23 was equivalent to a 9th grade reading level. The next level up is at 1080 Lexile. We are confident that students will continue to make progress.
- c. The number of students who have completed at least a semester's worth of Literacy credits increased from 76 to 104.
 - i.Ideally, we'd like this number to be higher, showing that more students are supported by our Literacy Program.
 - d. One area where there was a small decline is in the Parent Surveys.
 - i. Only 116 parents completed the annual survey last year. The Parent Surveys are critical

to improving our programs. At the end of the meeting today, you'll have an opportunity to complete the survey.

V. Reclassification

- a. Students who speak a language other than English at home may receive an EL designation when they start school. We work with all of our EL students toward reclassification.
- b. Reclassification means these students are considered proficient in English. If parents are not sure if their child is considered an English Learner, they should contact their child's teacher or administrator.
 - c. Reclassification for this school year has concluded and students that did not reclassify will be expected to take the ELPAC in the spring. In addition to ELPAC score, students will also need
 - qualifying score on the NWEA
 - 5 credits of English
