III. California School Dashboard, Comprehensive Support & Improvement, Differentiated Assistance

Principal Jon Oates explained what the CA Dashboard is and how parents use it as a tool to learn about school progress.

- He updated the audience on metrics on the CA School Dashboard, discussing improvements in ELPI, ELA, Math, and Graduation Rates.
- He discussed the difference between the 1-yr grad rate versus the 4-5 year grad rate.
- He led the discussion regarding Differentiated Assistance and CSI and how tutoring is one of the primary drivers for change. He prompted the audience for their input. He asked if attendees agree that tutoring is a meaningful support in SGI's and student interventions to improve academic progress. One student said that they appreciate the extra support in learning new skills.
- Parents in the audience agreed by a show of hands, a couple thumbs up and nods of agreement. A parent said that they like the SGI classes and would like to see more.
- Principal Oates directed the audience to the documents available online.
- Another student said they appreciate the pace and of the work and that they need breaks when learning
